





Eleanor Collins (born Elnora Ruth Procter; November 21, 1919)[1][2] is a Canadian jazz singer, television host and civic leader. She is known as the Canadian First Lady of Jazz. [1][3][4][5]

Early life [edit]

Elnora Ruth Procter was born on November 21, 1919, in Edmonton, Alberta. Her parents were of Black and Creole Indian heritage and were originally from the state of Oklahoma. They were drawn to the area by a 1906 advertisement to purchase a quarter section (160 acres (65 ha)) of land for \$10, among more than 10,000 black homesteaders who did so. [3][1][4][2][6][7] As a girl, she sang and played hymns, religious songs, and anthems, and was involved in Shiloh Baptist Church in Edmonton, a congregation formed by those recent immigrants.[4][2][8]

Music and media career [edit]

At age 15, she won a talent contest in Edmonton. [2] She then sang with Joe Macelli's dance band, and the Three Es,[4] and on CFRN.[9]

In 1938, she relocated to Vancouver and began performing with the Swing Low Quartette, a gospel group that consisted of Collins, her sister, Ruby Sneed, along with Edna Panky and Zandy Price. [4][8] They performed on CBC Radio
