# *Subscribe to Open (S2O)* 订阅开放资源的S2O模式

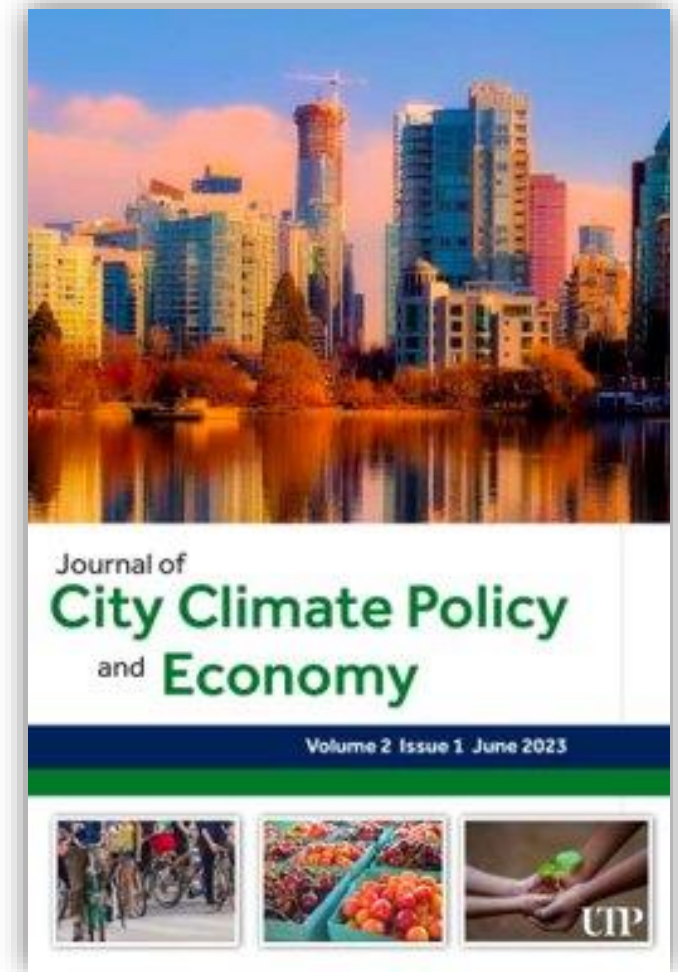
- Sustainable and equitable business model
  - **Benefits:** Advantages for researchers, libraries, and the community
  - **Access:** Institutional subscribers access content via subscriptions
  - **Annual Threshold:** Meeting the threshold enables open access for the volume year
  - **Open Access:** Content becomes freely accessible to all
  - **Cost-Free for Authors:** Eliminates costs, promoting wider access

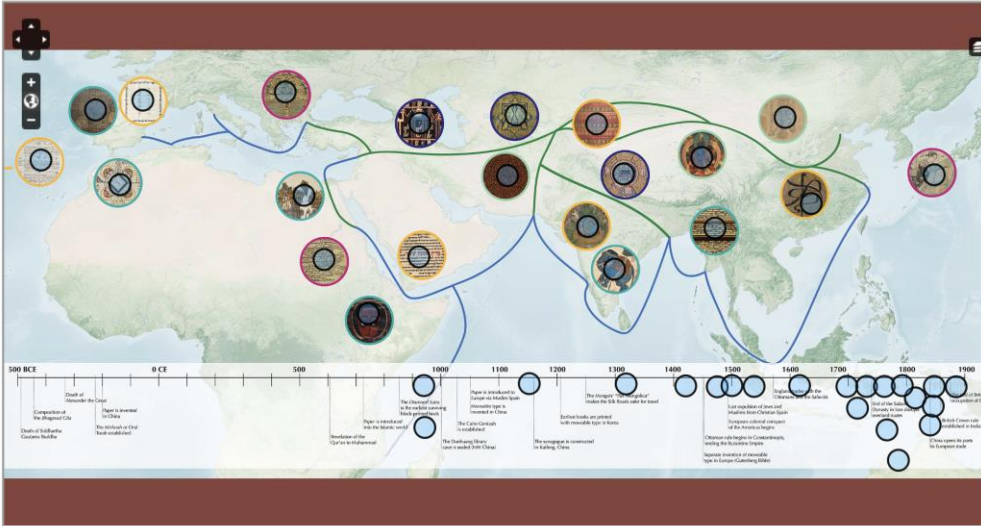

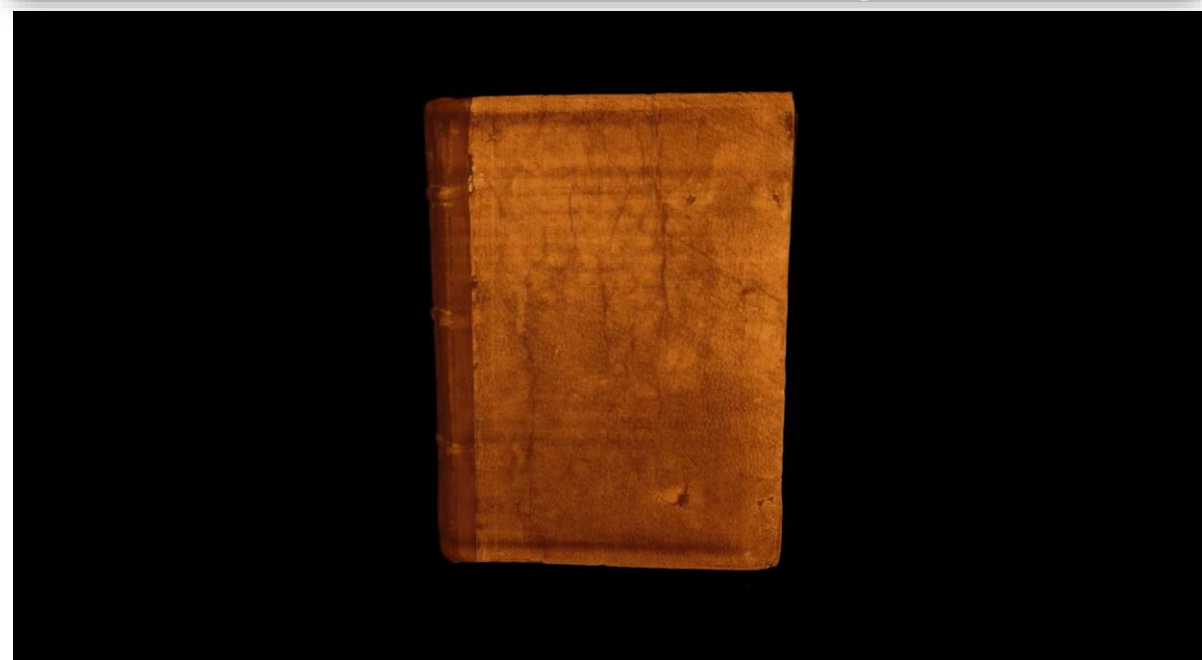

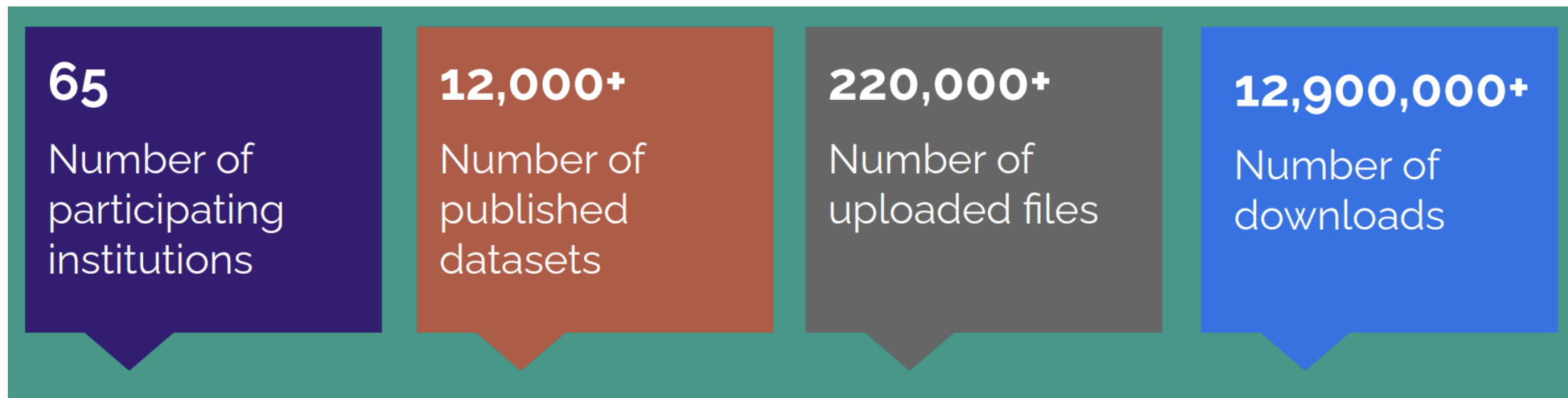

**Eleanor Collins** (born **Elnora Ruth Procter**; November 21, 1919)<sup>[1][2]</sup> is a Canadian jazz singer, television host and civic leader. She is known as the Canadian First Lady of Jazz.<sup>[1][3][4][5]</sup>

### Early life [ edit ]

Elnora Ruth Procter was born on November 21, 1919, in **Edmonton**, Alberta. Her parents were of Black and Creole Indian heritage and were originally from the state of **Oklahoma**. They were drawn to the area by a 1906 advertisement to purchase a quarter section (160 acres (65 ha)) of land for \$10, among more than 10,000 black homesteaders who did so.<sup>[3][1][4][2][6][7]</sup> As a girl, she sang and played hymns, religious songs, and anthems, and was involved in Shiloh Baptist Church in Edmonton, a congregation formed by those recent immigrants.<sup>[4][2][8]</sup>

### Music and media career [ edit ]

At age 15, she won a talent contest in Edmonton.<sup>[2]</sup> She then sang with Joe Macelli's dance band, and the Three Es,<sup>[4]</sup> and on **CFRN**.<sup>[9]</sup>

In 1938, she relocated to Vancouver and began performing with the Swing Low Quartette, a **gospel** group that consisted of Collins, her sister, Ruby Sneed, along with Edna Panky and Zandy Price.<sup>[4][8]</sup> They performed on **CBC Radio**
